Fill out and remove the response card portion and put it in the enclosed envelope.

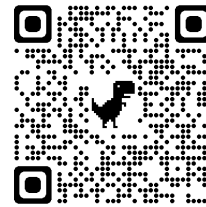
As an act of faith I/we share this intention for full participation in Central's mission and ministry. I/we understand that changes can be made to this intention at any time.
