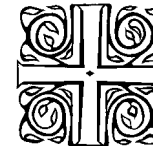

1949 – 2025

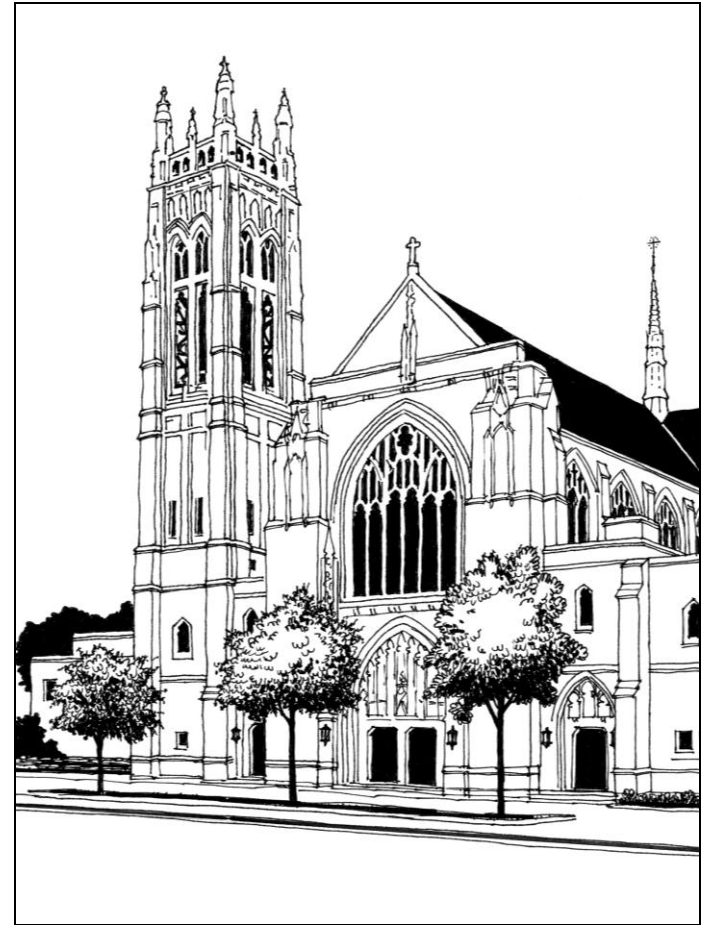


The family of Larry James Angeles of Golden Valley is saddened to announce his unexpected passing on December 12, 2025, at the age of 76.

Larry was born July 28, 1949, in Minneapolis. He graduated from Bloomington Kennedy High School in 1967. He joined the U.S. Navy the next year and his service included one tour of active duty in Vietnam. He received an honorable discharge in 1971. He worked in auto sales, enjoyed watching baseball and spending time at his cabin on Mille Lacs Lake. Larry was raised to the sublime degree of Master Mason in 1975 with the Cataract Lodge. He joined the Zuhrah Shrine in 1986 and was a member of the Shrine Drum Corps and the Royal Order of Jesters for over 25 years.
